

2 DAY LONDON ITINERARY

Day One

Tower of London

Book ahead; arrive at opening (9 or 10am). Plan for at least 2 hours minimum.

St Dunstan in the East

Free. No booking required.

Skyscraper Views

Pick Sky Garden, Garden at 120, Horizon 22, or The Lookout. Free but try to book ahead.

Lunch at Leadenhall Market

Osteria Del Mercato for adults, Pizza Express for families. No booking required.

St. Paul's Cathedral

Book ahead during peak travel seasons.

Shopping in Covent Garden

Check out Covent Garden Market & surrounding areas.

Pre-Theatre Meal

Casual: Seven Dials Market. Nicer: The Palomar.

West End Show

Book ahead. Use Today Tix for last-minute deals.

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Day Two

Buckingham Palace

Palace only open in summer. Book well ahead.

OR Changing of the Guards

See guards along The Mall or in front of the Palace.
Arrive around 10 for 10:45 parade Mon, Wed, Fri & Sat.

Choose One “Big 3 Museum”

Choose the Natural History Museum, Victoria & Albert Museum, or the Science Museum. All Free. No booking required.

OR Churchill War Rooms

Book ahead.

OR Westminster Abbey

Book ahead during peak travel seasons.

Afternoon Tea

Usually offered ~12pm-5pm. Book ahead at fancy places. Sometimes there's a dress code.

Big Ben & Houses of Parliament

Interior tours hard to get; view from Victoria Embankment or Westminster Bridge.

The London Eye

Book ahead during peak travel seasons.

Thames Cruise or Uber Boat

From Westminster Pier or Waterloo Pier. No booking required.
